SUBJECT: Awarding of College Credit for AFJROTC Courses for Cadets

1. We are pleased to remind AFJROTC instructors that your cadets have the opportunity to earn approved elective credits at two separate regionally accredited institutions: Adams State and UCCS. Both Adams State and UCCS have aligned their courses to the current AFJROTC curriculum units and will give our cadets Freshman level academic credit for satisfactorily completing our courses
2. The following websites describe the programmatic requirements, registration and transcript request details for your cadets. Based upon how you manage to the AFJROTC curriculum objectives, you and your cadet decide which 16 elective credits best suit your local program. Please read the details which best suit your local objectives and abilities at the following links. If your cadets are interested, review the courses at each institution and help your students decide which courses best match your local program. The AFJROTC instructor's only requirement is clearly stated in the first link for each institution, and the cadets opportunities are in the second link:
